Alcohol

1. No sale/supply of alcohol shall be made when there is no Designated Premises Supervisor in respect of the premises licence
2. No sale/supply of alcohol shall be made when the Designated Premises Supervisor does not hold a Personal Licence or when his/her Personal Licence is suspended
3. Every sale/supply of alcohol under the premises licence shall be made, or authorised, by a person who holds a Personal Licence

Annex 2– Conditions consistent with the operating Schedule

The Premises Licence Holder shall ensure that the following licence conditions are fully complied with:

General

The sale of alcohol and provision of late night refreshment shall only be for guests and visitors to the hotel.

Prevention of Crime and Disorder

CCTV shall be installed to cover indoors and outdoors and shall be maintained in good working order.

CCTV and Crime Prevention notices shall be displayed.

Open containers shall not be taken from the premises.

Protection of Children from Harm

A separate family meal area shall be provided.

All children shall be accompanied by an adult.

A proof of age scheme shall be operated.

No adult entertainment or services, activities, other entertainment or matters ancillary to the use of the premises that may give rise to concern in respect of children shall be provided.
