Urgency Notice

In accordance with the Local Authorities (Executive Arrangements) (Meetings and Access to Information) (England) Regulations 2012, 28 clear days notice of a decision on this report, to be considered by Cabinet on 21 March 2024, was not practicable.

This report has also been circulated less than 5 working days before the Cabinet makes any decision on the matter and will only be considered if approved at the meeting by the Chair (Leader of the Council).

Under special urgency rules in the Council's Constitution, the Chair of the Residents' Services Select Committee has kindly agreed that a decision on this matter can be considered at this Cabinet meeting because it is urgent and cannot reasonably be deferred.

The reason for urgency is due to the sharp increase in levels of homelessness and the imperative need to reduce the cost of temporary accommodation by securing more affordable, longer-term leased accommodation. This will support the Council in meeting its statutory responsibilities and mitigate the impact on the Council's budget.

Notice of the Council's intention to hold this meeting (part in private) is set out on the main Cabinet Agenda A for this meeting.
