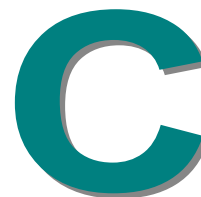

- **Item 14 – Development of the Civic Centre Car Park, Uxbridge into a Residential Care Home**

In accordance with the Local Authorities (Executive Arrangements) (Meetings and Access to Information) (England) Regulations 2012, 28 clear days notice of a decision on this report, to be considered by Cabinet, was not practicable.

This report has also been circulated less than 5 working days before the Cabinet makes any decision on the matter and will only be considered if approved as urgent at the meeting by the Chair (Leader of the Council).

Under the Council's Constitution, the Chair of the Corporate Resources & Infrastructure Select Committee has been notified about this report and agreed that a decision on such matters is urgent and cannot reasonably be deferred.

The reason for urgency is to ensure the Council does not cause undue delay in plans for a future care home, which is a critical project to ensure the council deliver vital social care savings over the long-term, aligned with the MTFs.
