Travel and parking



Emergency procedures

In accordance with the Local Authorities (Executive Arrangements) (Meetings and Access to Information) (England) Regulations 2012, 28 clear days notice of an upcoming decision on this supplementary agenda item was not practicable (i.e. on the Forward Plan).
