available to it and in doing so has taken into account the London Local Authorities Act 1990 and the Council's Street Trading Policy. The Sub-Committee has paid particular attention to paragraphs 3.2, 9.1, 10.5 and 10.7 of the Street Trading Policy. The Licensing Sub-Committee has determined that it is necessary and proportionate to refuse a temporary Street Trading Shop Front Licence for Dawood Halal Meat of 18 Botwell Lane, Hayes, UB3 2AA.

RESOLVED: That the application for a street trading licence be refused.

It was confirmed that there was no right of appeal.
