178.	5 CHILTERN ROAD, EASTCOTE - 54673/APP/2018/4154 (Agenda Item 6)
	Part two-storey, part single-storey side/rear extension and conversion of roofspace to habitable use, including four rooflights and alterations to side elevations.

Officers introduced the application and noted the addendum.

The Councillors noted that the application was for rooflights and side windows, and stated that the obscure glazing was welcome. As such, the officer's recommendation was moved, seconded and unanimously agreed.
