**The Decision:**

The Sub-Committee listened to all representations and considered all the relevant evidence and the submissions made by all of the parties, both orally and in writing, and in doing so took into account the:

- Licensing Objectives, Licensing Act 2003;
- Hillingdon's Licensing Policy and;
- Guidance issued by the Secretary of State and in particular, the Steps to Promote the Licensing Objectives (Paragraphs 8.41 – 8.49), Determining actions that are appropriate for the promotion of the licensing objectives (Paragraphs 9.42-9.44) and Reviews Arising in Connection with Crime (Paragraph 11.27).

In reaching its decision, the Sub-Committee carefully considered the evidence and the range of powers available to it and resolved to:

1. Remove the Designated Premises Supervisor
2. Modify the conditions of the premises licence
3. Suspend the licence for a period of 3 months

The meeting, which commenced at 10.00 am, closed at 3.46 pm.
