Attending, reporting and filming of meetings

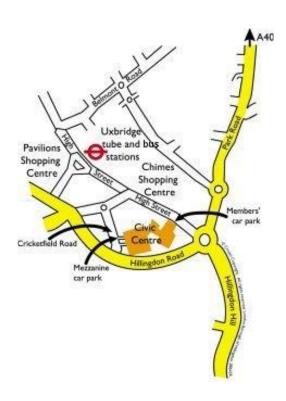
