[Subsequent to the meeting, officers provided the following responses.

"In relation to (1), a successful application to join the Homes and Communities Agency's affordable housing programme will provide additional resources for the council to develop supported housing. It will not in any sense make it compulsory for people to move out of residential care. It will however provide older and vulnerable people with a greater range of housing choices which will help to maintain their independence.

In relation to (2, the statement has been clarified and means that capacity within the Corporate Landlord will be required in terms of staffing resources to project manage the works. The Corporate Landlord has considered the implications of a successful application and supports the recommendations in the report."]
