44.	<p>TO AGREE THE MINUTES OF THE MEETING HELD ON 21 JANUARY 2014 <i>(Agenda Item 4)</i></p> <p>RESOLVED: That the minutes from the meeting dated 21 January 2014 were agreed as an accurate record.</p>
45.	<p>CONSIDERATION OF THE DRAFT FINAL REPORT ON WATER CONSERVATION <i>(Agenda Item 5)</i></p> <p>Consideration was given to the draft final report. It was noted that the scope of this report had not focussed only on the Borough's "award-winning" green spaces as had been stated in the scoping report. Instead, the review had explored water conservation measures for all green spaces across the Borough.</p> <p>It was agreed that the reference to the Borough's "schools" in recommendation 2 would be changed to "education establishments" to ensure that information on water-saving measures was shared as widely as possible.</p> <p>The Committee also agreed that a reference to the positive impact that these recommendations would have on flooding in the Borough would be included in the "Changes to Policy" section. It was noted that the issue of flooding and the wider effects of climate change would be a good subject for a future review.</p> <p>RESOLVED: That, subject to the amendments set out above, the draft final report on water conservation was agreed.</p>
