**Re: Application for a Premises Licence- Licensing Act 2003**  
**Address: The White Bear Public House, Wood Lane, Ruislip, HA4 7DF**

I refer to the application for a Premises Licence under the Licensing Act 2003, relating to the above named premises.

The Environmental Protection Unit, in its capacity as a responsible authority, is making a representation to this application, in relation to the licensing objective 'Prevention of Public Nuisance'.

The White Bear is located on Wood Lane, in a mainly residential area. The nearest residential accommodation are the houses on Seaford Close.

The grounds for this objection are:

The potential for noise nuisance from the use of the external areas to the rear of the premises, particularly the rear dining terrace and rear garden.

Should the Licensing Sub-Committee be minded to grant the licence, the following condition is recommended:

- The rear dining terrace and rear garden shall be cleared of all patrons and closed between 22:00 and 09:00 except for access to the car park.

I would therefore invite the Licensing Sub-committee to consider this representation when making their decision regarding this application.
