**POLICE OBJECTION NOTICE**

On Thursday 12<sup>th</sup> February 2015 police received an application for the above premises for one application under section 100 Licensing Act 2003. The Temporary Event Notice application is for Sunday 22<sup>nd</sup> February 2015 from 00.00hrs until 05.00hrs on Sunday 22<sup>nd</sup> February 2015. This application has been made by Miss Claudette St Paul.

On behalf of the Commissioner of Police I wish to make an objection to this application based on the Prevention of public Nuisance Objective. On the grounds that police have been receiving numerous complaints from local residents about noise and nuisance and anti social behaviour being caused by customers leaving the premises in the early hours of the morning.

There have been complaints about people urinating in the public places in full view of the resident's houses. On the 28<sup>th</sup> December 2014 at about 05.00hrs police were called to Dawley Road after the road was completely blocked by large vehicle that could not pass each other and this was caused by the amount of vehicles that were parked on the footpaths on both sides of the road, these vehicles belonged to people attending the premises. Officers also observed people coming out of the premises at this time. The premises was meant to be closed at 01.00hrs
