**Re; Premises licence application;  
Supermarket 88 - 90 High Street, West Drayton, UB7 7DS**

On behalf of the Commissioner of Police I wish to make a representation to the application for the grant of a premises licence at the above venue.

Our representation is in support of the licensing objectives. The prevention of crime and disorder, nuisance and the protection of children from harm.

This application for a new premises that is going to be operating as a Convenience Store, News Agent and is applying for a premises licence to sell alcohol.

- **Monday to Saturday 06.00hrs to 00.00hrs.**
- **Sunday 07.00hrs to 23.00hrs.**

The premise is in an area that has problems with Anti social behaviour caused by youths and street drinkers congregating outside the shops. It is therefore important that a number of measures are incorporated to assist the premises running consistently with the licensing objectives.

The police support the proposed conditions listed in the premises licence application form but would also recommend

**1/** The counter shall be a minimum distance of one meter from the floor and at least 60 cm wide. Access behind the counter shall be via a door bolted from the inside. The floor behind the counter shall be raised 10cm above normal floor level.

**2/** All alcohol products shall be stored in direct line of sight from the cashier's position and not obscured by other displays or shelving. If any part of the display is obstructed then this must be covered by CCTV

**3/** Products with an abv above 35% shall be stored behind the counter.

**4/** The till shall be placed under the counter or if on the counter it shall be fixed into position so that it cannot be easily moved.

5/ The CCTV system shall be kept in good working order. One camera should be in a position to record all transaction at the counter, another the area where the alcohol is displayed and a third to record all head and shoulders of persons entering the store. A forth the area immediately outside the entrance door to the premises.

6/ There shall be two adult staff members on the premises between 7pm and up until the close of business each day.

Should the above be agreed before any hearing date the police would be in a position to reconsider the representation proceeding.

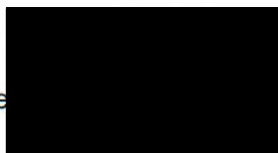
