On Wednesday 12th October 2016 The Police Licensing Team carried out a licensed visit at the premises, they were in the company of a London Borough of Hillingdon Trading Standards officer and a counterfeit expert from Surelock Global Invertigators.

During the licensing visit police established the following licensing offences:

1/ No Personal licence holder in the premises. -

Annex 3 Paragraph 8 - There shall be a person licence holder on duty at the premises at all times during opening times.

2. Finding Mr Amarjeet Singh who is excluded from the premises in the premises.

Annex 3 Paragraph 17 - The premises licence holder shall exclude Mr Ulgeet Singh and his spouse, Mr Jasmeet Singh and his spouse and Mr Amarjeet Singh and his spouse from the premises and all of its business and operational activities including all licensable activity at all times.

3. Defective CCTV system.

Annex 3 Paragraph 3 - The CCTV system shall be maintained in effective working order and any recording shall be made available to the police and any Authorised Officer of the Council on request.

4. Unable to produce invoices or receipts for alcohol when asked.

Annex 3 Paragraph 14 - All receipts/invoices relating to all purchases for goods at the premises must be kept in accordance with the statutory terms and made available for inspection at the request of the Metropolitan Police Service or an Authorised Officer of the Council.

5. Inspection of the premises incident/log book, resulting in no entries listing the defective CCTV, Police visits etc.

Annex 3 Paragraph 12.

An incident log shall be kept at the premises and shall be made available to Police and authorised Officers of the Council on request. The incident log shall be used to record any incidents, dates and times and the name of staff member involved.

Incidents can include but not limited to:

- a. All crimes reported by the premises to the Police;
- b. Any incidents of disorder/anti-social behaviour;
- c. Any faults with the CCTV system and details about remedial action/repair;
- d. Any refusal of age restrictions;
- e. Any visit by an authorised officer or emergency services

Further visit carried out on Wednesday 26th October 2016, during this visit further licensing breaches were evident.

6. Finding Mr Jasmeet Singh Lamba who is excluded from working in the premises in the premises.

Annex 3 Paragraph 17 - The premises licence holder shall exclude Mr Ulgeet Singh and his spouse, Mr Jasmeet Singh and his spouse and Mr Amarjeet Singh and his spouse from the premises and all of its business and operational activities including all licensable activity at all times.

7. No letter of authorisation to sell alcohol from the DPS.

Annex 3 Paragraph 9 - The DPS shall provide all staff members with written autorisation for selling alcohol, records and copies of authorisations shall be available to authorised officers on request.

8. No up to date training records.

Annex 3 Paragraph 11 - No member of staff shall make sales of alcohol until such time as the member of staff completes a recognised training course. Training will be reviewed regularly and updated training shall be provided in accordance with changes in legislation and staffing.

Lotus Food & Wine was previously owned by Mr Ulgeet Singh. On Wednesday 16th December 2015 the premises was taken to a licensing review by Hillingdon Trading Standards and was supported by the Metropolitan Police Service after a quantity of Non Duty paid alcohol and tobacco products were found on two separate visits carried out by the Metropolitan Police Service, Trading Standards and the HMRC. As a result of this review the Licensing Sub Committee made the decision to revoke the premises licence.

On the 18th January 2016 the Police Licensing Department at Uxbridge Police Station received an application from the present Licence holder Mr Aamir Singh LAMBA for a new premises licence to be granted.

The Metropolitan Police, Trading Standard and Hillingdon Trading Standards had concerns about this application due to Mr Lamba's connection with the business and the previous owner and about his experience and knowledge of the Licensing Act 2003 and ability to operate and control a licensed premises.

The responsible authorities had several meetings with Mr Lamba and on the 25th May 2016 his application was heard by a Licensing Sub - Committee, who made the decision to grant Mr Lamba a premises licence.

Further to the above the Police have attached further statements and CCTV images to support this application.
