

Urgency Notice - consideration of the budget for 2019/2020

13 December 2018 Cabinet meeting

Cabinet will be meeting on the 13 December 2018 at 7pm to consider the publication its budget proposals for the ensuing financial year for consultation. Following this, final approval of the budget will take place at the Council meeting on 21 February 2019.

How to I find out more about the Cabinet meeting and the budget?

Along with other matters on the agenda, the budget will be considered by Cabinet in public and residents are welcome to attend the meeting at 7pm in Committee Room 6 here at the Civic Centre. Furthermore, the budget report itself is available to view on the Council's website, by inspection at the Civic Centre or in the Borough's libraries. Residents are welcome to attend the Cabinet meeting. It will also be broadcast live, and later, on demand, via our YouTube channel: *Hillingdon London*.

What is the purpose of this notice, and why is the report urgent?

This is formal notice under The Local Authorities (Executive Arrangements) (Meetings and Access to Information) (England) Regulations 2012 to confirm that in excess of 28 clear days notice of this key decision on the budget has been given for transparency and advance public notice. However, the budget report itself has been circulated less than 5 clear working days before the Cabinet meeting and it will be considered only if the Chairman agrees it to be urgent. The reason for urgency is to ensure the Council can agree its annual budget within the necessary statutory timescale for Council Tax fixing and also for ensuring the required consultation period on the Cabinet's budget proposals.

Notice of the Council's intention to hold this Cabinet meeting (part in public and part in private) is set out on the main Cabinet Agenda A for this meeting.
