43.	<p>CONSIDERATION OF EXECUTIVE DECISIONS TAKEN AND ANY CALL-INS (<i>Agenda Item 5</i>)</p> <p>Members gave consideration to the Cabinet reports of the 24 January 2019 and the decisions made by Cabinet on them earlier that evening.</p> <p>On the budget monitoring report, Members discussed the forecast overspend on the contingency provision for Looked After Children in part due to an increase in the number of high cost residential placements and also a unit cost increase in such placements. The recurring issue of the deficit on the Dedicated Schools Budget was raised along with the risks associated with. Members noted some schools had substantial reserves and stressed the importance of the role of the Schools Forum in tackling such financial pressures. Vacant posts within Trading Standards were highlighted and assurances were sought on whether this was having an impact on local consumer protection services.</p> <p>RESOLVED: – That the decisions made by the Cabinet at their meeting on 24 January 2019 be endorsed and that no call-in be made.</p>
