a) General – all four licensing objectives (b,c,d,e) (please read guidance note 11)

The Premises Licence Holder, Mr Austin Whelan, has a wealth of experience in the licensed trade and is a multi-site operator with several other premises in Croydon, Kingston, Cricklewood and Uxbridge. Mr Whelan takes his responsibilities under the Licensing Act 2003 very seriously.

The application proposes to amend the licensing plan in accordance with drawing L01 dated February 2019 which accompanies this application. The proposed changes to the internal layout consist of the addition of a raised area and reconfiguration of fixed seating. The proposal also includes a refurbishment of the external area including an existing outbuilding becoming an additional trade area and forming part of the licensed area. The proposed expenditure for the refurbishment is over £200,000. Please note that the amendments to the licensing plan should not take effect until such times as the works proposed have been completed and the Licensing Authority have been notified.

The application has also been submitted to update the Premises Licence conditions to ensure that they are suitable for the style of operation at the premises. We have taken the opportunity to replace the existing operating schedule, which is obsolete in parts, and offer proportionate conditions.

b) The prevention of crime and disorder

1. The premises shall install and maintain a comprehensive CCTV system. All entry and exit points will be covered enabling frontal identification of every person entering. The CCTV system shall continually record whilst the premises are open for licensable activities and during all times when customers remain on the premises. All recordings shall be stored for a minimum of 28 days with date and time stamping. Viewing of recordings shall be made available upon the request of Police or

authorised officer throughout the entire 28 day period.

2. A record shall be kept detailing all refused sales of alcohol. The record should include the date and time of the refused sale and the name of the member of staff who refused the sale. The record shall be made available for inspection at the premises by the Police and Trading Standards at all times whilst the premises are open
3. An incident log shall be maintained at the premises and details of all known incidents recorded within the log.
4. The need for door supervisors shall be assessed by way of a risk assessment carried out by the Designated Premises Supervisor and cognisance will be taken of any Police advice
5. Where SIA registered door supervisors are used at the premises, a record must be kept of their SIA registration number and the dates and times when they are on duty

c) Public safety

d) The prevention of public nuisance

6. Notices shall be prominently displayed at all public exits and in the external area requesting customers to respect the needs of local residents and leave the premises and area quietly
7. No customers shall be allowed to use any external area of the premises after 23.00 on Sunday to Thursday and midnight on Friday and Saturday, except for customers permitted to temporarily leave the premises to smoke and no drinks shall be permitted to be taken into any external area after these times.

e) The protection of children from harm

8. Children under the age of 18 must be accompanied by an adult over the age of 18 at all times whilst on the premises and must be off the premises by 23.00, unless attending a private function or on New Year's Eve
9. A Challenge 21 proof of age scheme shall be operated at the premises where the only acceptable forms of identification are recognised photographic identification cards, such as a driving licence, passport or proof of age card with the PASS hologram

Notes for Guidance

This application cannot be used to vary the licence so as to extend the period for which the licence has effect or to vary substantially the premises to which it relates. If you wish to make that type of change to the premises licence, you should make a new premises licence application under section 17 of the Licensing Act 2003.

Combined fighting sports – defined as a contest, exhibition or display which combines boxing or wrestling with one or more martial arts – are licensable as a boxing or wrestling entertainment rather than an indoor sporting event.
 - Live music: no licence permission is required for:
 - a performance of unamplified live music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, on any premises.
 - a performance of amplified live music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day on premises authorised to sell alcohol for consumption on those premises, provided that the audience does not exceed 500.
 - a performance of amplified live music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, in a workplace that is not licensed to sell alcohol on those premises, provided that the audience does not exceed 500.
 - a performance of amplified live music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, in a church hall, village hall, community hall, or other similar community premises, that is not licensed by a premises licence to sell alcohol, provided that (a) the audience does not exceed 500, and (b) the organiser gets consent for the performance from a person who is responsible for the premises.
 - a performance of amplified live music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, at the non-residential premises of (i) a local authority, or (ii) a school, or (iii) a hospital, provided that (a) the audience does not exceed 500, and (b) the organiser gets consent for the performance

- on the relevant premises from: (i) the local authority concerned, or (ii) the school or (iii) the health care provider for the hospital.
- Recorded Music: no licence permission is required for:
 - any playing of recorded music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day on premises authorised to sell alcohol for consumption on those premises, provided that the audience does not exceed 500.
 - any playing of recorded music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, in a church hall, village hall, community hall, or other similar community premises, that is not licensed by a premises licence to sell alcohol, provided that (a) the audience does not exceed 500, and (b) the organiser gets consent for the performance from a person who is responsible for the premises.
 - any playing of recorded music between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, at the non-residential premises of (i) a local authority, or (ii) a school, or (iii) a hospital, provided that (a) the audience does not exceed 500, and (b) the organiser gets consent for the performance on the relevant premises from: (i) the local authority concerned, or (ii) the school proprietor or (iii) the health care provider for the hospital.
 - Dance: no licence is required for performances between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, provided that the audience does not exceed 500. However, a performance which amounts to adult entertainment remains licensable.
 - Cross activity exemptions: no licence is required between 08.00 and 23.00 on any day, with no limit on audience size for:
 - any entertainment taking place on the premises of the local authority where the entertainment is provided by or on behalf of the local authority;
 - any entertainment taking place on the hospital premises of the health care provider where the entertainment is provided by or on behalf of the health care provider;
 - any entertainment taking place on the premises of the school where the entertainment is provided by or on behalf of the school proprietor; and
 - any entertainment (excluding films and a boxing or wrestling entertainment) taking place at a travelling circus, provided that (a) it takes place within a moveable structure that accommodates the audience, and (b) that the travelling circus has not been located on the same site for more than 28 consecutive days.
