Appendix 2 - Summary of amendments to application

Withdraw the part of the application for recorded music and reduce the terminal hour for late night refreshment, sale of alcohol and opening hours to midnight Su nday to Thursday and 1.00am on Friday and Saturday.

Re - word existing conditions:

Prevention of crime and disorder

The installed CCTV system shall be maintained in effective working order at all times. The CCTV system shall retain all recordings for a minimum of 31 days and shall contain the correct date and time of the image capture. Recordings shall be made available immediately upon request to the Police and/or authorised officers of the London Borough of Hillingdon.

Protection of children from harm

A Challenge 25 scheme shall be operated at the premises. Only photographic ID shall be acceptable as proof of age (passport, photo driving licence, or PASS card).

Add following conditions:

The prevention of public nuisance

No noise shall emanate from the premises nor vibration be transmitted through the structure of the premises that gives rise to a nuisance.

The external back door shall be kept closed between 19.00 hours and closing, except for the immediate access and egress of persons.

Notices shall be prominently displayed near the entrance and exit doors requesting patrons to respect the needs of local residents and leave the area quietly.

Staff shall monitor customers smoking outside the premises on a regular basis to ensure patrons do not cause a public nuisance.

Protection of children from harm

Staff shall be trained in responsible alcohol retailing. Staff training records shall be made available for inspection upon request by officers of a Responsible Authority
