Specifically, I have personally observed instances where a crime has been committed and/or a police presence required recorded at Aren's Bar (on Joel Street), Champers (on Field End Road), the Ascot Pub, and the Manor House before that (on Field End Road) and, perhaps most obviously, at the RE:Bar (also on Field End Road). There are probably others too. Unfortunately, the correlation between alcohol consumption and crime/disorder is clear and I am very concerned that this extension will result in an increase of this, specifically given the later time that alcohol is proposed to be served.</p> <p>As far as I am aware, there has been no consultation with residents and/or local neighbourhood/council organisations regarding the likelihood of an increase in crime/disorder and, therefore, I believe that such an outcome is inevitable.</p>

The increased noise levels from the Aroma Lounge and the impact this will have on all residents, and in particular children, needs to be considered. The impact on the number of hours of sleep that will be possible will have a negative impact on all residents, especially children, as will the impact of increased noise (from patrons, as well as music).</p> <p>Furthermore, the likelihood that smokers will congregate on the street outside the venue will lead to a deterioration of air quality, which will equally have a disproportionate impact on resident children.</p>

I have encountered very drunk people in the area, as well as broken glass. It is also worth noting the decrease in air quality as a result of increased levels of tobacco smoke that will inevitably accompany an licence extension.</p> <p>In conclusion, I believe that if this license application is granted then it will inevitably lead to an increase in crime/disorder and public nuisance, it will impact children in a harmful way, and it will impact public safety too.</p>

The outcome you are seeking from the Licensing Authority (See note 6);

I would request that the Licensing Authority REJECT the application to vary a premises license at the Aroma Lounge on the basis that this extension will not achieve the licensing objectives as detailed above.

At the very least, I would urge the Licensing Authority to grant the application with fewer hours (i.e. the sale of alcohol for consumption to 11.00 p.m. in line with other premises in the area).
