I note the application is for indoor and outdoor live music until 12.00 on weekdays and 1.00 am on weekends. This is still a densely populated residential area, with flats above each shop unit. Given the extensive problems with very loud, persistent and anti social music and general noise caused by Captain Morgan's Pub at 210, it seems inappropriate to be dishing out a late noise license to a property opposite it. Why does a
