Jhini,

Thank you for sending this application review through to us for comment.

As a Ward Councillor for Brunel Ward, I wholeheartedly support this review, as the property trading as the Prince of Wales has caused numerous issues in the local vicinity since it was refurbished and re-opened. As highlighted in the report there have been multiple breaches, all knowingly undertaken by the owner/licence holder, from both a planning a licensing perspective.

There are regular incidents of anti-social behaviour, many although I am sure not all have been reported to the Council and Licensing team, as well as a failure from the premises to ensure the safety of not only its own customers but those people in the nearby vicinity as well. In addition as the report mentions there has been an instance where police and emergency services have needed to be called.

The report clearly identifies a number of failings on behalf of the property, many of which have been highlighted previously with warnings issued yet no action has been taken to attempt to correct any of these. The premises cannot control its patrons, it serves food and drink outside of the times and locations that it is permitted to do and management ignore this with flagrant disregard to local residents.

To reiterate I am in full support of this review, and hope that given the previous performance and warnings issues that have been completely ignored that the license for this premises is revoked in full.
