Re: 'Review of a Premises License'

The Police Licensing Team would like to make the following representations in support of the Trading Standard Services for Hillingdon Borough. The review of the Premises License of 'Best Food and Wine, Station Road, West Drayton. UB4 8JF.

The Metropolitan Police Service is supporting this review in line with the Licensing objectives and in particular The Prevention of Crime and Disorder.

On the 27th August 2019 The London Borough of Hillingdon Trading Standards Services, accompanied by a tobacco detection dog unit attended Best Food and Wine' 61 Station Road, West Drayton. This was an intelligence led inspection following information received from a concerned parent. At the venue illicit tobacco and medicinal products were detected and seized by Trading Standards Officers.

The Station Road area of West Drayton has undergone significant re-generation in the past few years however the area still suffers from anti-social behavior, street drinking and drug misuse complaints.

The premises Licence Holder and Designated Premises Supervisor, Mr. Hameet KHANEJA has neglected to observe the Licensing Objectives under crime and disorder. When a local business flouts the law in a challenging area by selling non duty paid products and tobacco and medicines, that have not been quality tested prior to sale then as a responsible authority we must do all we can to protect the public and the livelihood of legitimate traders.

The Police Licensing Team would like to support Trading Standards in their review of the premises licence with the view of suspending the Licence for a period of three months in order to allow the owner to bring the business into compliance. In addition, The Police Licensing Team fully support the proposed conditions set out by Trading Standards.
