SHREE NEWS, 53 SALISBURY ROAD, EASTCOTE, HA5 2NJ

I can confirm the Licensing Team have received recent complaints regarding your opening hours. The licence stipulates that the premises must cease trading at 19:00 Monday to Sunday.

Officers from the council did visit the parade on Wednesday 24th February 2021. I can confirm the premises was still operating past 19:00.

Following a further visit to the premises on Tuesday 30th March 2021 the following conditions were not being adhered to.

- The premises licence was not prominently displayed
- The CCTV was displaying an incorrect time
- Challenge 25 proof of age scheme was not being implemented
- No signage was displayed reminding customers of the Challenge 25 scheme
- Whilst not a condition part of Challenge 25 encourages a refusal's register to be implemented. No such register was being kept.

It has also come to my attention that the premises from Hillingdon Council's estates team that the lease only permits alcohol to be sold until 19:00.

An application currently being determined by the Licensing Section is requesting alcohol be sold past 19:00. As a Hillingdon Council Officer, it's my duty to remind you of the following.

Should a licence be granted potentially you would be breaching you lease agreement should you sell alcohol past 19:00 Monday to Sunday.

Representations have been received to this application. The reasons for the restrictions is to prevent Public Nuisance and Anti - Social Behaviour in the area of Salisbury Road. The representations received reflect these concerns.

Further visits to Shree News may take place prior to the hearing on Tuesday 27th April 2021 at 14:00.
