I am writing to you regarding the application for a new premises license submitted by Mr Senal Turson for the above premises. I wish to make a representation against this application based on the following licensing objective:

Prevention of Public Nuisance

The applicant has applied for recorded music, live music and the performance of dance on Sunday to Thursday from 10.00 – 00.00 and on Friday to Saturday from 1.00 – 02.00, with an extension to 05.00 on New Year's Eve. While it is not clear if the music would be amplified or not, it should be noted that there are many residential units surrounding the premises.

85 High Street was previously a bank, which operated normal business hours and did not cause any nuisance to neighbours. It is likely that many noise complaints would be received by the Council if this application were to be granted as it stands.

The ASB Team suggests that the premises ceases recorded or live music on Sunday to Thursday at 23.00, 00.30 on Friday and Saturday and on 03.00 on New Year's Eve. It is also suggested that sound insulation and a noise limiter be installed at the premises, in order to minimise any noise nuisance to neighbours.

In addition to these issues, it is also suggested that a comprehensive plan on customer dispersal be submitted to the Council. The noise and associated nuisance from take away and delivery vehicles also needs to be taken into account.

This can be described as a noise sensitive area and recent complaints that premises of this nature are likely to generate complaints and prove to be a noise nuisance to local residents.

I am happy to discuss the above points with the applicant and intend to be present at the hearing to verbally deliver this representation.
